Located conveniently between Coronation Plaza and Serene Centre, this eatery boasts "Authentic Aussie Best" and "Money Back Guarantee". Does Mad Jack live up to its claims?

Well, you won't leave feeling dissatisfied! For the Fish & Chips, the fillet was deep-fried with a crispy batter. The fries were cooked to perfection, with a mixture of plain and spiced fries. As for the Grilled Salmon in Cream sauce, the meat was grilled evenly, and coupled with a generous helping of mashed potatoes. The Cheezy Baked Rice, with its thick layer of melted cheese and sumptuous meat slices, is perfect for cheese lovers. However, the Grilled Rib-Eye Steak, while filling, didn't tantalize our tastebuds.

Another highlight would be the drinks and dessert. Those worthy of mention include "Fruit of the Forest", a mixed-berry smoothie, and "Detox Agent", a beetroot-cucumber concoction. Items are a bit pricey though, with an average price of \$4 for drinks, and main courses starting from \$5. Student meals are available at \$4.50.

Eating at Mad Jack's also proved to be an enjoyable experience, with the cozy ambience and pop songs playing in the background. An X-box 360, with games such as FIFA 2006 and HALO 2, await you. They also welcome students to study from 2pm to 5pm.
